Webinar report on topic "ROLE OF DRAMA & THEATRE IN CLASSROOM" organised by COE,PATNA by resource person Ms.Padmalaya Choudhary (Educator) focusses on following main points-

- -The word theatre comes from the Greek word "THE THEATRON" meaning "A place for viewing". It is a dramatic art-a story told through actions and performed live.
- -Points 4.21 of NEP-2020 speaks about the role of drama and theatre in education in preparatory level (standard 3 to 4) and middle group (standard 6 to 8).
- In Preparatory level from standard 3rd to 5th, teachers act as a teacher act as writer, actor ,story teller and director whereas the student act as audience and actor during the teaching learning process with reference to the role of theatre and drama in education.
- -In middle group that is from standard 6 to 8 ,teacher act as writer, editor ,organiser whereas the student act as storyteller director and actor during the teaching learning process with reference to the role of theatre and drama in education.

She beautifully explained the mode of teaching through dramatic activities in preparatory and middle schools through various videos and also explained its role in teaching-learning process as incorporated in NEP-2020.
