Webinar report on topic” **CONSTRUCTIVISM**” organised by **CBSE,COE, NOIDA** ,by resource person **MR.GUNENDRA KUMAR MISHRA (EDUCATIONIST)** focusses on following main points-

Constructivism:

- the theory that says learners construct knowledge rather than just passively take in information. As people experience the world and reflect upon those experiences, they build their own representations and incorporate new information into their pre-existing knowledge.
- an important learning theory that educators use to help their students learn. Constructivism is based on the idea that people actively construct or make their own knowledge, and that reality is determined by your experiences as a learner.
- argues that knowledge and reality do not have an objective or absolute value or, at the very least, that we have no way of knowing this reality.

Role of the teacher in the social constructivist:

- classroom is to help students to build their knowledge and to control the existence of students during the learning process in the classroom.
- “constructivist teachers allow student responses to drive lessons, shift instructional strategies, and alter content”.

Piaget's theory of constructivism argues that people produce knowledge and form meaning based upon their experiences. Piaget's theory covered learning theories, teaching methods, and education reform.
