Ideas for this kind of speaking

- Find and share the positives about a child's learning, behaviour and experiences. ...
- Be open and honest. ...
- Think before you speak, especially when you're talking with parents about difficult or sensitive issues.
- Ask for parents' input. ...
- Let parents make the decisions.

Best way for teachers to communicate with parents

Good two-way communication

- Parent conferences.
- Parent-teacher organizations or school community councils.
- Weekly or monthly folders of student work sent home for parent review and comment.
- Phone calls.
- E-mail or school website.

Importance of Parents Communication

There is plenty of evidence that shows positive communication between parents and teachers helps improve academic performance. So ongoing communication with child's teacher is essential to make sure they can tailor their approach to child while in class.

Listening to parents

Listening is the foundation of effective communication. When you listen well, you get more information about children and their families. You also get the full benefit of parents' in-depth knowledge of their children.

Why is communicating with parents so important to your success in the classroom?

But when teachers and parents work together, they can equip students for academic success. ... When parents and teachers communicate, parents are more likely to trust teachers and appreciate their impact. And teachers who communicate with parents report feeling happier and more competent as an educator.
