Experiential learning:

- The experience provides the platform for learning; the careful analysis and reflection of the experience develops the learning.
- Knowledge is created through the transformation of experience.
- Knowledge results from the combination of grasping and transforming the experience

The cone of learning:

I see and I forget, I hear and I remember, I do and I understand

- Confucius

After two weeks we tend to Remember-

- 10% of what we read
- 20% of what we hear
- 30% of what we see
- 50% of what we see and hear
- 70% of what we say
- 90% of what we say and do

How to enhance experiential learning?

- encourage quality learning
- encourage questioning
- encourage brainstorming
- expand discussions at home
- ideas from reading or issues in local news can provide construction materials.

In Experiential Model Kolb described two different ways of grasping experience-

- abstract conceptualization
- concrete experience

He also identified two ways of transforming experience-

- active experimentation
- reflective observation
