## POINTS DISCUSSED IN WEBINAR: "Storytelling as a Pedagogy"

1. Traditional story telling has been a part of human life since we first left Africa 200,000 hypothetically or even more years back.

Perhaps storytelling was the reason language developed in the first place as our minds began to inquire, wonder, think.

- 2. Why do we tell story:
  - **♣** Whether in cave or cities, storytelling remains the most innate and important form of communication.
  - All of us tell stories
  - The story of your day.
  - **4** The story of your life.
  - Workplace gossip,
  - **4** The horror on the news.
  - **♣** Our brain is hard wired to think and express in terms of a beginning, middle and end.
- 3. The art of Storytelling
- 4. Why you need to use Storytelling for learning
- 5. Active Story-Based Learning (ASBL)

ASBL helps children to learn language, Science and Mathematics and develop general awareness and critical thinking, through stories and activities.

- 6. The Style is Important:
  - It is important at this stage to describe a style.
  - **♣** Don't relay on just "speaking" the story . Don't sit still in a chair , walk around.
  - ➡ Talk slowly, with alternating rhythm, use hands a lot.
  - Tell the truth, even when it's difficult.
  - **♣** Dress up in props and ask kids to follow the instructions in the story and replace the dialogues you say.
  - Use digital aids , appeal to their senses
  - 4 And, most importantly, invite children from the audience to act out the story as you tell it.
- 7. Incorporating Story Telling
  - Plan
  - Create
- 8. What is in a Good Story:
  - Hook the listener in the opening
  - **Lead of the Every part is essential**
  - Draw the theme out of your story
  - Keep it simple. Students should be able to retell back to you
  - **Keep eye contact**
  - Create extraordinary out of the ordinary
- 9. Some way that Story Telling can be applied to the class room setting:
  - Create a story to illustrate new concepts or ideas.
  - **Lesson** Express a topic or theme by narrating a story about it.
  - **Lesson** Explain historical events by narrating theme as stories.
  - **♣** Invent a story of historical figures meeting one another or characters from different stories meeting.
