Principles and visions:

Readiness and planning :

- general readiness assessment daily or weekly readiness assessment
- preparing for if someone gets sick
- special consideration and resources

Guiding principles: Lowest risk

if students and teachers engage in virtual -only classes, activities and events.

More risk- if small in-person classes, activities and events .Groups of students stay together and with the same teacher throughout or across school days and groups do not mix. Students remain at least 6 feet apart and do not share objects.

Highest risk- if full sized in- person classes, activities and events. Students are not spaced apart ,share classroom materials and supplies and mixed between classes and activities.
