Education in a post covid word-Nine ideas for public action:

- Strengthened public commitment to education as a common good.
- An expanded understanding of the right to education.
- The importance of the teaching profession and teacher collaboration.
- An emphasis on student youth and children's participation and rights.
- Protecting the social space of the school in the transformation of education.
- Free and open-source technologies for teachers and students.
- Scientific literacy with in a curriculum based on strong purpose.
- The need to protect domestic and international financing of public education.
- A global solid solidarity that does not accept current levels of any Inequality.

Principles and visions:

High stacks choices guarded by share principle and visions of desirable collective features.

Readiness and planning:

- general readiness assessment daily or weekly readiness assessment
- preparing for if someone gets sick
- special consideration and resources

Guiding principles: Lowest risk

if students and teachers engage in virtual -only classes, activities and events.

<u>More risk-</u> if small in-person classes, activities and events .Groups of students stay together and with the same teacher throughout or across school days and groups do not mix. Students remain at least 6 feet apart and do not share objects.

<u>Highest risk-</u> if full sized in- person classes, activities and events. Students are not spaced apart ,share classroom materials and supplies and mixed between classes and activities.

- Provide information on proper use, removal and washing of cloth face coverings.
- Train staff on all safety protocols.
- Conduct training virtually. Maintain social distancing during training.
