Webinar report on topic” STORY TELLING IN CLASSROOM “organised by COE,CBSE,DELHI (NOIDA) by resource person MS. RANJANA BHARADWAJ (EDUCATOR) focusses on following main points-

- Storytelling is a human art form that teaches about the human experience. ... Stories help teachers reach novices in ways they cannot with other dry, rote, deductive strategies. They bring disparate information to life in a meaningful and connected way.
- When a story is being told, it usually has an underlying message or lesson that the speaker is trying to convey to its audience. Storytelling is an excellent tool. It helps explain expectations, strengthen character and teach desired behaviour within a workplace.

Other benefits of using storytelling in the classroom:

- Promote a feeling of well-being and relaxation.
- Increase children's willingness to communicate thoughts and feelings.
- Encourage active participation.
- Increase verbal proficiency.
- Encourage use of imagination and creativity.
- Encourage cooperation between students.

Strategies for Introducing New Read Aloud in the Classroom:

Look at the Book Cover or Title Illustration
Open to the Story and Read the Pictures
Discuss Possible Predictions and Make a List of Questions
Introduce New Vocabulary and Concepts
Relate Concepts to Students' Background Knowledge and Personal Experiences.

Benefits of storytelling for kids:

- Installs virtues in your little one
- Boosts their listening skills
- Fosters their imagination
- Increases their cultural understanding

- Enhances their communication skills
- Help sharpen memory
- Makes learning easier
- Improves social skills

Storytelling is one of the oldest and most effective forms of teaching. A well-told story enables the speaker (lecturer) and the listeners (students) to optimize the learning process by integrating cognition, emotion and imagination in the didactic process. Good storytelling is an art and a skill
