- A graphic novel uses images, often in a comic strip style to tell a story. With pictures or illustrations and a lot less text, graphic novels help kids practice reading. They also can help kids build positive associations with books.
- graphic novels has helped many of my students to become stronger readers with more traditional texts. Graphic novels have added another layer to these lessons, and visual elements can support struggling students to engage in this work with more ease.
- Graphic novels will improve your child's reading skills like any other book would, and they are fantastic choices for reading outside of class.
