- Communication :- An ability to transmit or transfer any information, feeling, idea or viewpoint to others without hesitation.
- Critical Thinking: Enables a student to be argumental, logical, analytical, rational and scientific in nature.
- Creativity:- Skills to look and consider things and ideas from fresh perspective, through an innovative thoughts and new ways of doing.
- Health and fitness: Ability to perform physical tasks efficiently and motivates to take balance diet and remains fit.
- Social Responsibility:- Involves respect for traditions, customs, individual differences, constitution and related rules and regulations.
- Ethics:-It develops positive attitude, honesty, compassion, integrity and performing duties.
- Scientific Temper: Promotes logical and critical thinking and evidence based information.
- Collaboration: Encouraged to adapt and empower the children through group activities in collaboration with others and enhance their confidence.
