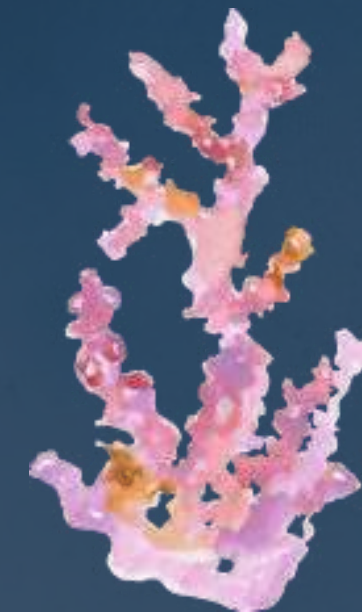
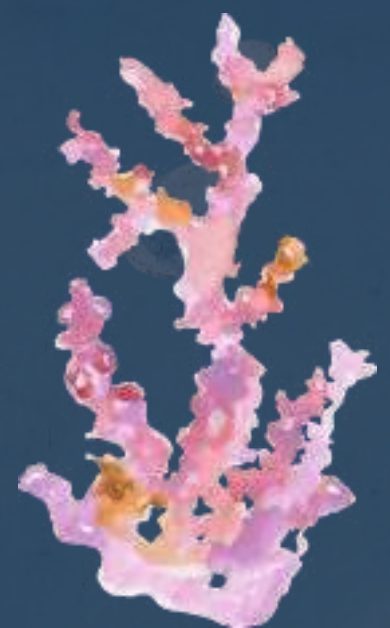

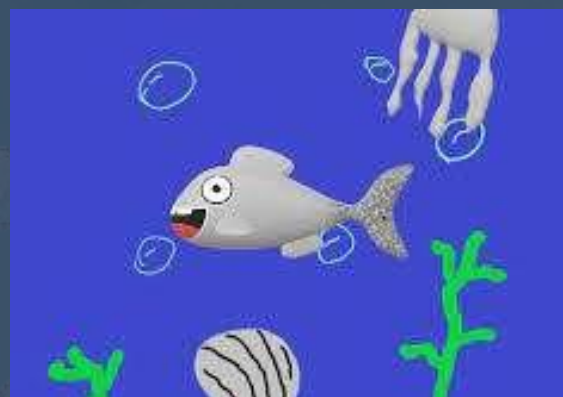
Activity 1-Make an aquatic animals using 2D like square, rectangle, circle, triangle, etc. Do this in your math practical file or A4 Sheet.

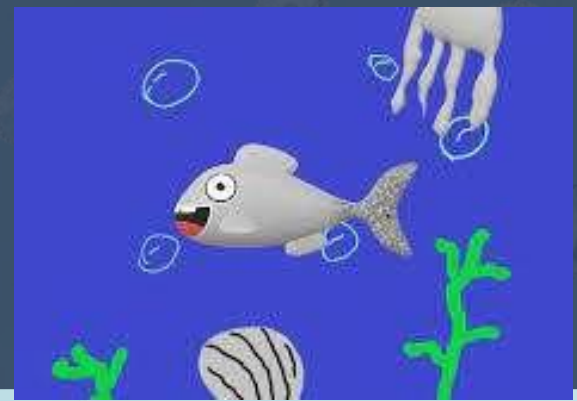
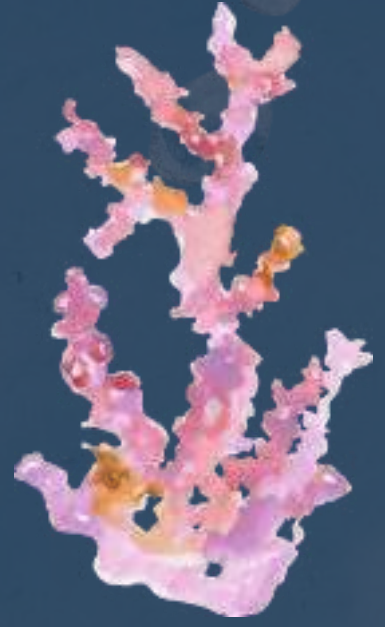


Dear students,
