The PTA meeting held on August 17, 2022, addressed several key academic and non-academic issues.

#### **Academics:**

- Students is being participated in external educational tours.
- Remedial classes for Class XII students have begun, with availability extended to others as needed. These classes aim to support weaker students, with notifications sent to parents.
- Zero-period revision classes are being held for primary and middle school students.
- Regular tests for Classes X and XII are being conducted to monitor progress.

# **Parent Concerns and Resolutions:**

- Remedial support for phonics (Class 1) and comprehension issues (Class 2) will be addressed.
- Consideration for short breaks during the school day will be reviewed.
- More computer classes for primary students will be implemented.
- Parents addressed concerns about 10<sup>th</sup> class English copy corrections, drawing books, and the availability of the 7th-grade computer book. Matter taken un to consideration and cleared.
- Solutions will be explored for classwork left unfinished due to activities.

### **Non-Academics:**

• The school is enhancing career counselling services and is in the process of appointing a dedicated career counsellor or psychologist.

# **Transport:**

Concerns about LPG-operated private transport were noted, with a call for proper verification.

Parents visited various labs including Biology, Chemistry, Physics, and Computer labs.

The meeting underscored the school's commitment to addressing academic and operational concerns while enhancing educational experiences.
